

How to make stained glass Easter eggs

1. Gather all the materials

You will need:

- Different coloured paper plates
- Different coloured cellophane
- Tape
- Scissors
- Sharpie/marker
- Ribbon and a hole punch if you want to hang them up!

You can purchase most of these materials from a party shop, craft shop or a \$2/reject shop. Some you may have lying around the house!



2. Draw an egg shape on the back of the plate and cut it out

TIP: You could use an egg template and draw around it with a marker.



3. Cut the cellophane into shapes

We had 5 different colours of cellophane and cut out 10 strips of each colour – which will make roughly 10 plates.

TIP: Make sure they are long enough to cover the back of the plate. We cut ours about 5 inches long and one inch thick.



4. With tape, stick the cellophane to the back of the plate

It's best to use tape over glue to avoid it getting messy. We ordered our colours like a rainbow – red, orange, yellow, green and purple (we couldn't find any blue!)

TIP: Make each strip overlap just a little so you don't leave any gaps between colours!



5. If you want to hang them up, hole punch the top of the plate and feed a ribbon through the hang

Voila! You have beautiful coloured stained glass eggs to decorate around the house.
